Dear Friends,

As we celebrate 200 years of service in Christ's name in the Cadiz community and beyond, our congregation through our church session has established a new fund to improve our church, its worship life and its building. Soon you will receive a letter asking you to contribute to the 200th Anniversary Fund.

In celebrating our history, we remember our past but look forward to our future. The funds collected for this cause will include an update to the multipurpose room in honor of Bill and Betty Hudson, additional sprucing up of the building, and the purchase of new hymnals.

With the help of our music staff and the Music and Worship Committee, the Church Session has approved the purchase of the *Glory to God Hymnal*, this is the newest song book of the Presbyterian Church U.S.A. Each book costs only \$20 and members and friends of the congregation are welcome to purchase a hymnal or hymnals in honor or memory of their loved ones.

Denominational press on this hymnal reads as follows: "This new book of congregational song will include:

- Over 800 hymns, psalms, and spiritual songs.
- Approximately 50% of included hymns will be from the 1990 Presbyterian hymnal [our current hymnal]. The remaining pieces will come from former Presbyterian hymnals, other denominational songbooks, and individual authors and composers.
- A musical setting of almost every Sunday lectionary psalm.
- Music from six different continents.
- Music covering all major historical and contemporary sacred genres, including approximately thirty-five African American/Gospel hymns.

Glory to God also contains worship aids and printed liturgies for Sunday service (including baptism and the Lord's Supper) and services for daily prayer. Complete orders of service will include congregational responses, prayers, and creeds. The pew edition of *Glory to God* is available in either of two colors, red and purple, in either of two versions: a Presbyterian edition and an ecumenical edition."

We will be purchasing the purple, Presbyterian version and hope to unveil it at our final 200th Anniversary celebration on October 1st.

Please prayerfully consider giving generously to the 200th Anniversary Fund. Our congregation has a tremendous history; let's start building its tremendous future together today.

All these events are free and open to the public so bring your friends and neighbors as we celebrate The Presbyterian Church of Cadiz, Ohio.

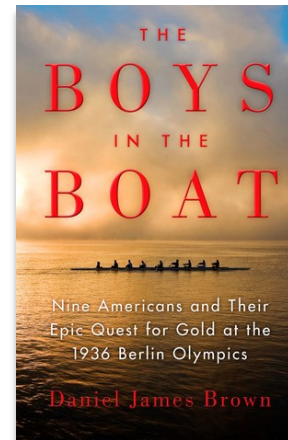
